

**TOWN HALL MEETING**  
**March 25, 2019**

The City Council of the City of Forest City, Iowa, met in a town hall meeting on March 25, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in the Waldorf University Salveson Hall Ballroom, 106 South 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Forest City, Iowa.
