WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Forest City fully endorses the project and supports the City of Scarville's application for Community Attraction and Tourism funds.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Forest City that the City Council endorses the project and supports the City of Scarville's quest for funds for the project.
