

RESOLUTION 23-24-25

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FOREST CITY TO SUBMIT AN IOWA REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TA) SET-ASIDE APPLICATION TO THE NORTH IOWA AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (NIACOG, RPA2) FOR THE TIM COFFEY TRAIL – PHASE 2C PROJECT

WHEREAS, NIACOG has made available funding through the Regional TA Set-Aside Program, and such funds may be used to provide for the construction of facilities for bicycle, pedestrian and non-motorized travel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Forest City desires to submit a TA Set-Aside application to gain funding support and to use said funding to construct the Tim Coffey Trail – Phase 2C Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Forest City has partnered with the Forest City Enhancement Committee, a 501c3 organization, to develop and execute the project, and provide for the local match funding; and

WHEREAS, the grant application requires an official endorsement of the proposed project from the sponsoring local government; and

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Forest City, Iowa, that the submission of the project application for TA Set-Aside is hereby approved; and if selected the City agrees that it will provide the necessary local match of \$60,000 plus engineering costs, maintain the project for at least 20 years, and allow for continued public use of the improvement.
