### **CITY OF FOREST CITY SHUTS WATER MAIN DOWN FOR REPAIRS**

Forest City – Due to a water main break, the City of Forest City will shut down water today, March 5, 2020, to make the necessary repairs. Areas affected are the High School and Middle School, Hillcrest Circle, 500 block of North 13<sup>th</sup> Street, all of Gilbert Street, and the 800 and 900 block of West M Streets. Water will be shut off for these affected areas from noon until the repairs are completed. The City anticipates water services will be restored by late this afternoon or early evening.
